GAME OPTIONS

STROKE

Play with up to six people at a time. Best individual score wins.

PAR 3 GAME

Play our regular courses, but at Par 3 distances. Best individual score wins.

BEST BALL

Team format. Golfers play their own ball and card their own individual score for each hole. Then, the team records the best gross score from amongst the team members to be used as the "team score" for that hole.

CLOSEST TO THE PIN

Each competitor gets three shots. Closest to the hole wins.

PUTTING COMPETITION

Each competitor gets five putts. Closest to the hole wins.

SKINS

Each hole is played separately, and is won by the player with the lowest score on the hole -- that golfer wins 'the skin'.

ALTERNATE SHOT

Team format. Two-person teams alternate hitting the same ball. The first player tees off, the second player hits the second shot, the first player hits the third shot, and so on until the ball is holed.

SCRAMBLE

Team format. Each team member hits a tee shot on each hole. The team then collectively decides which of the four balls is in the best position to play next.

LONGEST DRIVE

Compete with your friends to see who can hit the ball the furthest.

10-HOLE CHALLENGE

Target-based game on a real course. Points are awarded based on proximity to the hole, hitting consecutive greens, and staying out of trouble.

KNOW YOUR NUMBERS

DISTANCE: Total distance the ball traveled.

CARRY: The distance the ball traveled in the air before it landed.

BALL SPEED: The speed the ball traveled. This is created by club speed and impact. The faster the club speed and centeredness of the hit are the two main determining factors that will dictate ball speed.

BALL DIRECTION: This is the angle between the target line and ball path at launch. If you see "0" then your ball is traveling directly along the target line at launch.

LAUNCH ANGLE: The angle between the ball path and ground at launch. Swing speed and club selection will impact the launch angle as well as the angle of attack. For example, the average driver launch angle on the PGA Tour is 11.2 degrees.

BACK SPIN: The rate of backwards spin rotation on the ball immediately after impact. Spin rate is one of the least appreciated numbers in windy conditions. Typically, the more lofted the club, the more spin generated. This is why when playing in the wind we often club up.

SIDE SPIN: The rate of side spin on the ball. Depending on the amount of degrees will dictate a draw or fade.

IMPACT ANGLE: This is the direction the club is heading at impact. Positive numbers indicate "in-to-out" for right hand golfers but negative numbers indicate "in-to-out" for left handers.

PEAK VERT: Maximum height the ball reached during its flight.

PEAK HORIZ: This measures how far the ball traveled before it reached its maximum height.

SEP. DIST: How far from the center line the shot ended up.

HEAD SPEED: The rate of your club head speed at impact. More club speed means more potential distance.

SMASH FACTOR: The ratio between club speed and ball speed -- literally ball speed divided by club speed. Smash factor is an indicator of how efficiently energy is transferred from the club head to the ball. There is an optimal smash factor for each club, ranging from a driver at 1.50 to a pitching wedge at 1.25.
