OFFICIAL RULES

TOURNAMENT OUTLINE

- Tournament Format: 2 Player Team Scramble. 18 Holes.
- Tournament Scoring: This is a GROSS scoring tournament.
- Tournament Dates: May 7th – 20th, 2023.
- Tournament Course: PGA National.
- One 18 Hole Round: Lowest 18-Hole Score Wins. Playoff if Needed (May 21st, 2023).
- Simulator Time: 2.5 Hours.



PRIZE

- First place team wins two TaylorMade Stealth 2 Plus Fairways.
- This event is part of the 2022 - 2023 X-Cup Championship series.
The grand prize of the championship is a golf trip to the Casa de Campo Resort!

WHO CAN PLAY

- This is a 2 Player Team Event.
- Open to all customers of X-Golf venues and to golfers of all levels age 21 years and older.
X-Golf Employees, Contractors, and Staff are excluded, and are not permitted to participate.
- When competing, Participating Players must have the X-Golf Mobile App and must be an active “Club Member” subscriber - Download the X-Golf Mobile App from either the Apple iOS Store or Google Play Store and establish your account prior to competitive play.

ENTRY / REGISTRATION

- Teams must register and schedule playing time with their home store General Manager, X-Golf Professional or X-League Coordinator, and may register to play any time before or during the Competition Round.
- Teams must submit their (1) Team Name (2) Player Names, and (3) The email address associated with each player's X-Golf Mobile App Profile.
- This is a 2 player team event. Players may play on multiple combinations of teams and enter multiple times during the Competition Round.

EVENT FEES

- There is no fee for this event.
- Participants pay simulator rental fees for the duration of Competition Round.
- In the event of a tie in the competition round, the venue will cover the cost of a playoff round.

DURING COMPETITIVE PLAY

- **All players must use their X-Golf Mobile App and Scan-In for any competitive round for results to be valid.**
- **At the end of your round, please contact X-Golf Staff to officially record your round – a photograph of your final scorecard MUST be captured by local staff to be valid.**
- The Team Captain must Scan-In FIRST and must follow any tournament or event procedures to correctly begin the onboarding process for the team on the system. Consult X-Golf Staff for specific procedures.
- Once the Team Captain has successfully registered him/herself, the remaining players on the team must scan-in to complete the onboarding process as specified for the tournament or event.
- During scan-in, all players must confirm their tee-off location and adjust accordingly before the start of competitive play. Players may not change their tee locations in mid-round.
- Only the player registered to the Mobile App used to Scan-In may play on his/her own behalf - Player substitutions are never allowed.
- Rounds must be completed within their respective round period, booked reservation time slot, and may not be paused nor completed in a separate setting.
- For Scramble Play, players may hit in any order regardless of which team member is loaded on the system to play next. Each player may only hit a designated shot once.

OTHER RULES

- **Men:** Blue Tees
Women: Red Tees
Seniors: Red Tees
- "Senior" Players are defined as players 65+ years of age.
- Players may not hit off of the Tee other than for Tee Shots.
- Max Stroke on any hole is DOUBLE PAR.
- Putting Preview may not be used at any time. A 2-stroke penalty will be assessed for each infraction. However, use of the L & R Arrows is allowed for use when putting.
- Mulligans are not allowed except for Systems Errors that are confirmed by X-Golf Staff.
- Refer to "Program Rules" for a more comprehensive list of program guidelines and tournament rules.
